Virtual Sites, <http://virtuallsites.umich.edu/>, is easy to connect to and has an abundance of resources. Just recently our office connected to Virtual Sites to use Adobe's InDesign program. Virtual Sites is also great for Mac users who want to use PC programs, such as Microsoft Outlook. Or if you want to try out Photoshop or Dreamweaver before you make the big purchase.
